

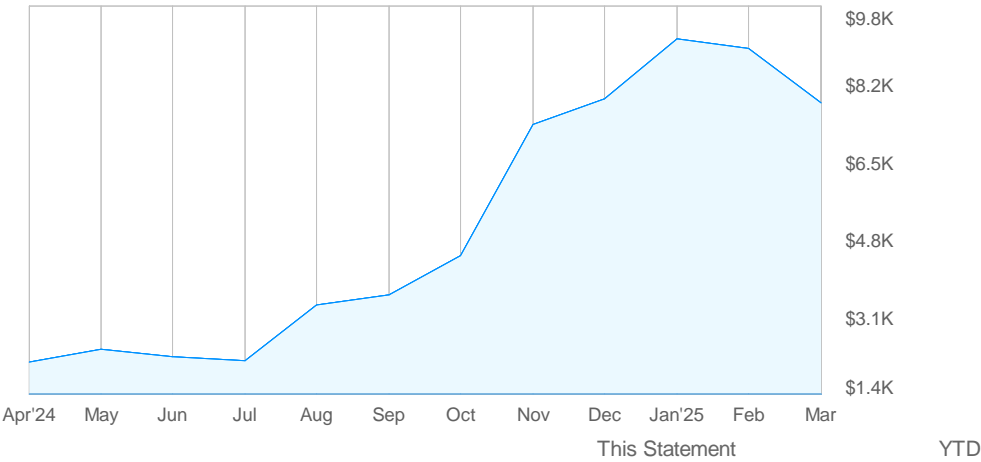

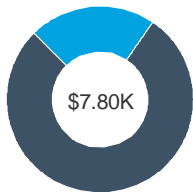

Certain Limited Partnerships (direct participation programs) and unlisted Real Estate Investment Trust (REIT) securities, for which you may see a value on your monthly Account statement that reflects the issuer's appraised estimated value, are not listed on a national securities exchange, and are generally illiquid. Even if you are able to sell such securities, the price received may be less than the per share appraised estimated value provided in the account statement.

Market Value: The Market Value is computed by multiplying the Market Price by the Quantity of Shares. This is the dollar value of your present holdings in your specified Schwab Account or a summary of the Market Value summed over multiple accounts. **Non-Publicly Traded Securities:** All assets shown on this statement, other than certain direct investments which may be held by a third party, are held in your Account. Values of certain Non-Publicly Traded Securities may be furnished by a third party as provided by Schwab's Account Agreement.
